1. Short information about GIZ Libya

- Providing products of high quality together with documents of conformity
- Providing quality after sales service

4. Indications for elaborating the offer

4.1 Technical Offer

The technical offer contains:

- The characteristics of the equipment
- Confirmation that all requested equipment is in stock and available for immediate delivery
- Certificates of guarantee of the equipment

The evaluation of the offers will be done based on the "evaluation grid" in annex 1. Between the offers that are considered as eligible, the most economical offer wins.

4.2 Financial Offer

For your financial offer please use annex 2. Please send your technical and financial offer in English. The offer must be submitted in EUR. The delivery cost must be included in the unit price.

The offer must contain an official commercial registration in Libya. The bidder must have a foreign bank account outside of Libya that can receive EUR payments. Please submit your commercial registration confirmation as well as a bank letter/details of your foreign bank account with the bid.
