



INVITATION FOR BIDS

Improving Primary Health Care Provision in Libya Bid Reference: Bid 91150818 osmosis_systems_air_compressors

In cooperation with the Libyan Ministry of Health (MoH), GIZ promotes the provision and expansion of Primary Health Care (PHC) services in Libya. The project's activities are currently divided into three intervention areas: 1) Increasing the operational capacity of selected PHC centers (PHCCs) through in-service training, implementing quality standards, procurement and rehabilitation; 2) training and continuing professional development for health care professionals; and 3) supporting hospitals and laboratories in COVID-19 testing and care. In addition, the project is currently undergoing an extension process to also include peace building measures in the future.

With this tender and as part of the hospital and laboratory support for COVID-19 testing and treatment, the project wishes to purchase 3 reverse osmosis systems including accessories as well as 3 air compressors including accessories. Additionally, 220 micro-USB to USB-C cables shall be procured.

Bidders should note and adhere to the following terms:

- Offers (technical and financial) shall be submitted in an **electronic version not later than 16/05/2021** to the following email address: **LY_Quotation@giz.de**. The subject line of the email should indicate the following title: **Bid 91150818 osmosis_systems_air_compressors**. Nonresponsive offers will not be considered.
- Bidders must have a foreign currency bank account **outside of Libya**.
 - Payments will be in EUR, TND or USD to the contractor's bank abroad.
 - GIZ cannot transfer money to Foreign Currency Accounts inside Libya.

To submit a complete offer, bidders must provide the following documents:

1. Technical Offer including:
 - a. Specifications of the equipment (as specified in ToR 2.1)
 - b. Manufacturer data sheets for the offered products
 - c. Certificate of guarantee for the offered items
2. Financial Offer (*Annex 2*) including the bidders bank details.
3. Copy of proof of foreign currency account abroad (in EUR, TND or USD) and information about the bank details (not older than six months).
4. Copy of commercial registration of the company in Libya

Incomplete offers will not be considered.
